Petra Reynolds

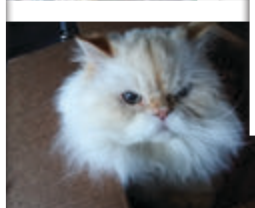
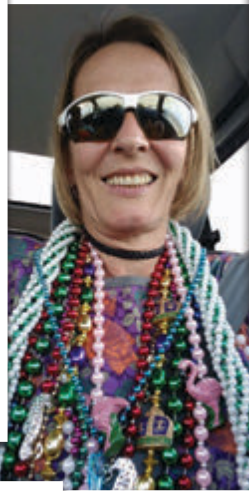

Crockpot Chicken & Dumplings



Ingredients

- 4 – Boneless, Skinless Chicken Breasts
- 1 – 24 oz pg Frozen Egg Noodles
- 2 – 4.7 oz cans of Cream of Chicken Soup
- 1 – 32 oz Chicken Broth*
- 1 stick of butter, sliced into 4 – 5 pieces
- Morton Nature's Seasons – Seasoning Blend
- Salt & Pepper
- Chicken Bouillon (I use Better than Bouillon)



Directions

Sprinkle Morton Nature's Seasons blend, salt and pepper on chicken breasts and place in the bottom of the crockpot or Insta-pot. Spoon and spread soup over the chicken.

Cut butter into several pats and place evenly over soup. If using the bouillon or chicken base, whisk it into the chicken broth and pour over soup.

Place lid on pot and turn on low. Cook for 6 hours or high for 4 hours. Insta-pot only takes 3 hours on low.

Remove chicken and tear into pieces. Add back to pot. Add noodles and cook for another 1-2 hours. Stir a few times during last hour.

~You may want to add more broth to thin out at the end of cooking.~

Sprinkle with parsley (if using) and enjoy!

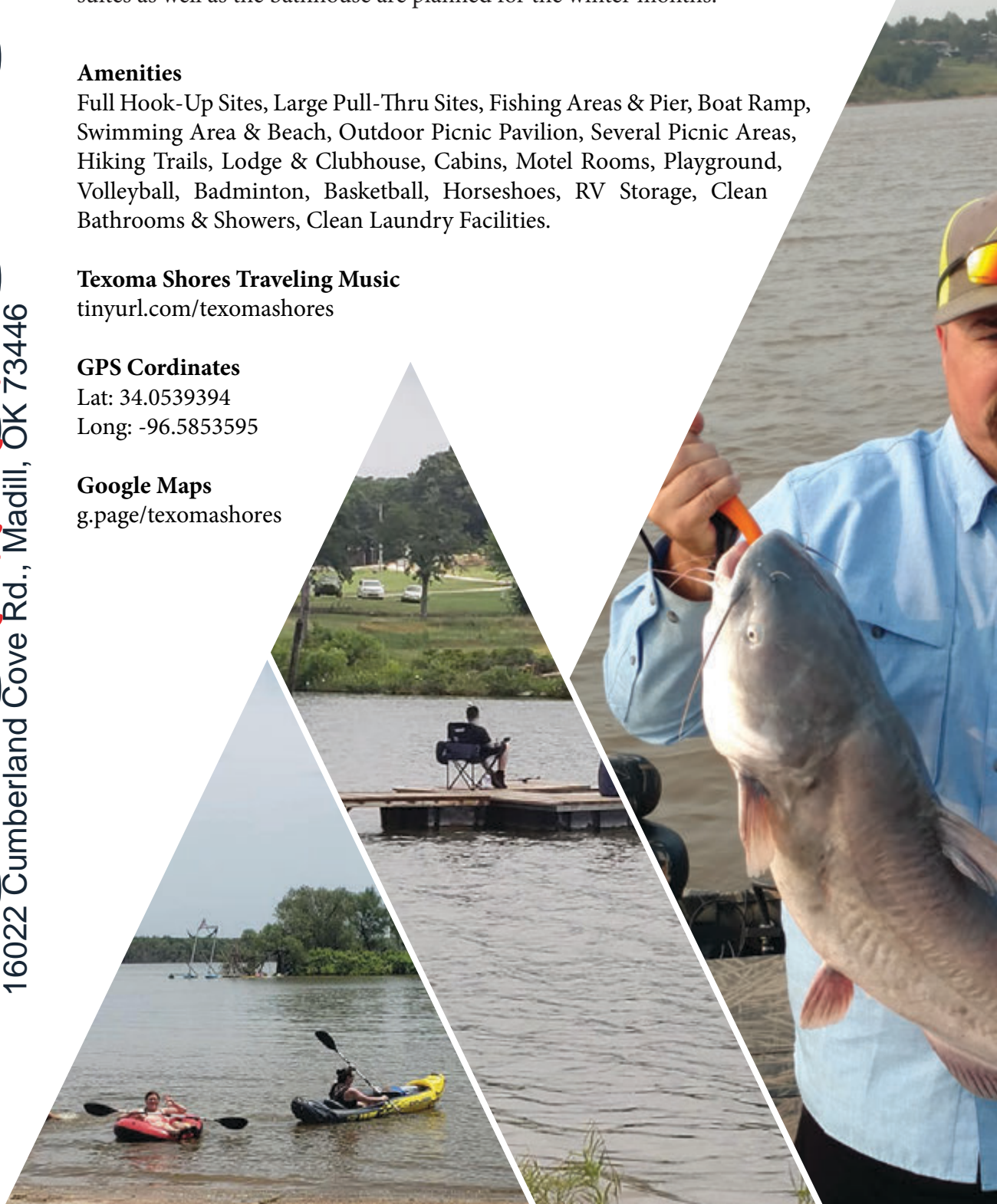
