

#### **CELEBRATING MIKE POURNOURY**

n May 21st of this year, OCP's President, Mike Pournoury passed away, and joined his maker in heaven.

Over the course of 65 years, Mike Pournoury encountered people from all walks of life. He was a part of people's lives across all 50 states and over 40 countries. Within these same years he had found Christ, married, had children, worked hard, graduated from college, started two successful companies, employed a lot of great people, and made a lot of friends.

Mike Pournoury grew up in Iran as part of a large family, with seven brothers and a sister. He followed in his father's footsteps in joining the Iranian Navy, which sent him to train at the Citadel Military College in Charleston, South Carolina. In 1979, when the government of Shah was overthrown by the Iranian Islamic revolution, Mike and several other Iranians studying at the Citadel refused to return to Iran. The US allowed him to stay and become a resident.

He began his journey in membership camping in 1979 with National American Company, now known as Thousand Trails. He made many major contributions to the success of companies such as Thousand Trails, Western Horizons, and Colorado River Adventures.

In 2007, he became the CEO and co-founder Ocean Canyon Properties, with his business partner Peter Graffman. On purchasing Millwood Landing RV Resort in 2008, he moved to Texarkana. Over the next 14 years, Mike helped build Ocean Canyon Properties to be one of the leaders in the membership camping industry. If you asked Mike what he attributed his success to, he would answer every time 'God'.

Mike met his wife, Amy, on Valentine's Day while attending church. When asked, he would gleefully retell the story of that fateful day. Mike and Amy have three children and two grandchildren. Mike's office was always decorated with the latest artwork from his two granddaughters.

His employees fondly remember his most used phrases as 'Mike-isms'. Phrases such as 'If you're going to be a bear, be a grizzly,' and 'How do you eat an elephant? One bite at a time' were often used in motivational conversation with employees and friends. We celebrate Mike's life as a mentor and a friend, with laughs and lessons we shared together.



#### MEET PETER GRAFFMAN







Peter Graffman grew up in Skowhegan, Maine, the son of a business owner. He later attended Boston University where he acquired his MBA with honors and studying for a doctorate in Business Administration. On graduation, Peter joined the faculty of the Boston University Business School. After 10 years in academia, went on to found three successful companies in the software and technology industry. He later started an investment firm where he was introduced to Mike Pournoury.

Peter first met Mike in May of 2007 through an associate of Mike's, while working with on an investment project. It was through this introduction that Peter learned about the membership camping business.

At the time Mike was Vice President of Sales and Marketing, at Colorado River Adventures (CRA), a membership camping company. On learning about the membership camping business from Mike, they teamed up to make an offer to purchase CRA. Despite several rounds of negotiations, CRA decided not to sell the company. Not long after, Peter received a call from Mike. Mike had left CRA to pur-

sue his dream of owning a membership camping company. Mike identified two resorts to purchase and asked Peter if he would go into business with him. After discussing it with his wife Jennifer, she was game, and in 2007 they formed Ocean Canyon Properties, purchasing their first two resorts, Millwood Landing and Tres Rios.

Peter has played a vital role in building Ocean Canyon Properties alongside Mike. Peter was responsible for designing, developing, and implementing the information systems that manage OCP's business and has been instrumental in growing the company through acquisition of new resorts. Peter's goal for Ocean Canyon Properties is continuing to develop OCP as one of the leading membership camping resort systems in the country. He is dedicated to investing in and improving the quality of our resorts and to give our members an unparalleled vacation experience.

Peter and his wife Jennifer have been married for 36 wonderful years. They have one daughter, Lauralee, and a sonin-law, Jake. Peter's outside interests include hunting, fishing, and gardening that he enjoys during his leisure time.



# Campfire Kitchen Slow Cooker Potato Soup

- 1 (30 oz.) bag frozen hash-brown potatoes
- 2 (14 oz.) cans chicken broth
- 1 (10.75 oz.) can cream of chicken soup
- 1/2 cup chopped onion
- 1/4 teaspoon ground black pepper, (more to taste)
- 1 (8oz) package cream cheese (softened)
- Optional Toppings: cheese, bacon, sliced green onions
- 1. In a slow cooker, combine potatoes, chicken broth, soup, onion, and pepper.
- 2. Cover and cook on low for 5-6 hours. If your potatoes are still in big chunks you need to cook it longer. They will start falling apart when it's ready.
- 3. Add the cream cheese and cook 30 minutes or until cream cheese is melted, stirring occasionally, until combined.
- 4. Top with cheese, bacon, or sliced green onions if desired.







have now been remodeled with new flooring, new beds, and updated décor. We have also resurfaced the floor in the shower rooms and painted the bathhouse.

On the resort, the fish cleaning station has been upgraded, granting the use of water and electricity. Stabilizing poles have been attached to the walkway of the fishing pier to the land. Fish have been added to the catch and release pond which has also been cleared to enhance accessibility. New nature trails have been cut for our outdoor enthusiasts to enjoy.

In the coming months, we will be continuing to remodel more motel suites.

The fishing pier will soon be sporting new handrails. Our cabins and lodge will be receiving a fresh coat of paint. And plans are in place to reshape and add sand to our swimming beach. If you haven't relaxed by our shores, come see for yourself.




