Campfire Kitchen with Sweet Amy P.

Old Fashioned Apple Crisp

Ingredients

5 lb. Granny Smith apples
Grated zest of 1 orange
Grated zest of 1 lemon
2 tbsp. freshly squeezed lemon juice
2 tbsp. freshly squeezed orange juice
1/2 cup granulated sugar
2 tsp. cinnamon
1 tsp. nutmeg (optional)

For the Topping:

1.5 cups of all purpose flour
3/4 cup granulated sugar
3/4 cup light brown sugar, packed
1/2 tsp. kosher salt
1 cup old fashioned oats
1/2 lb. cold unsalted butter, diced.



Directions

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Butter a 9 by 14 2-inch oval baking dish.

Peel, core, and cut the apples into large wedges. Combine the apples with the zests, juices, sugar, and spices. Pour into dish.

To make the topping, combine the flour, surgar, salt, oatmeal, and cold butter into a bowl. Combine until coursely combined together. Scatter evenly over the apples.

Place the crisp on a sheet and bake for 1 hour until the top is brown and the apples are bubbly.

Serve warm.
