



Great Pumpkin Dessert

Ingredients

1 can (15oz) solid-pack pumpkin

1 can (12oz) evaporated milk

3 large eggs

1 cup sugar

1 tsp vanilla extract

4 tsp pumpkin pie spice

1 pkg yellow cake mix (regular size)

3/4 cup butter, melted

1-1/2 cups chopped walnuts

Vanilla ice cream or whipped cream

Directions

- 1. In a large bowl, beat first five ingredients until smooth.
- 2. Transfer to a greased 13x9in. baking dish. Sprinkle with cake mix and drizzle with butter. Top with walnuts.
- 3. Bake at 350 for 1 hour or until a knife inserted in the center comes out clean. Serve with ice cream or whipped cream.
