COVID-19

WHAT WE'VE DONE

There have been a lot of crises in recent times, but America and its citizens are strong. We have some of the most resilient generations that have been born out of the Great Depression. We're sure that this Corona virus will soon pass. While the lessons learned will stay with us, the present effects will hopefully be over soon. We still live in the greatest country in the world.

Ocean Canyon Properties has been blessed that we were allowed to remain open. This is due to a great team of people that we have working for us at the resort level as well as the cooperation of our members and the research done at

the corporate level. We have spent hundreds of hours going through articles, participating in webinars with our federal, state and local officials and learning everything we can to make sure that we keep our members safe and staff safe and working.

Each state is requiring different restrictions. We are sensitive of the ongoing effort to open what and where we can as long as it can be done so with the health and wellness of members and staff intact. As some states roll out plans of opening back up, we will continue to assess our own situation and make decisions the best for our staff and members.

EVENTS & ACTIVITIES

The first thing we put on furlough were the events and activities. We quickly put a limit on the number of people we could have in a group but as soon as we did, the states wanted all group events to be cancelled.

One of the most encouraging things we've seen at the resorts is that the families have been interacting together in ways that will be hard to forget. We've seen parents out playing with the kids. We've seen the families riding bikes together, playing board games together, and doing crafts together. Just being together as families.

CLUB HOUSES

Ocean Canyon and all our staff are here to help make your time as enjoyable as possible. It was heartbreaking to have to close the clubhouses. As soon as we got word of how contagious the Corona virus was, we began to close down common areas and started to deep clean them. Many of the resorts deep cleaned the areas several times even through there was no one coming through them. These common areas will remain closed as long as the local governments requires. As they do begin to open, we will set limitations by resort on how they will be opened, how many are allowed at a time, and other rules so that we have the ability to maintain a clean and healthy environment.

POOLS

We have been asked to close the pools at all the resorts. As the states begin to loosen those rules and it is safe for our members, we will begin to reopen our pools. One question that will be raised is whether groups of kids or adults can remain distant and in respectable numbers. If this can't be accomplished, then we need to keep the pools closed until we can.

CABINS AND RENTAL UNITS

Rental units are a huge concern to us for two reasons. The first is that we do not want to spread the virus from one family to another when the reservations are back to back. At the same time, we must send someone into that cabin to deep clean it. This puts that person at risk. As some of you know, we cancelled all unit reservations in the month of May. Some states have begun to ease restrictions and have allowed units to be rented again as long as we left it vacant for 3 days after someone checks out. We have decided to increase that to 4 days in between for the safety of our members and employees.

OUR STAFF

Our staff has worked hard to make the best of this difficult situation. They truly are our most valuable asset and we appreciate everything they do.

1. Current members must register for access to the members-only portal. Simply click the "Registration" link on www.oceancanyon.com in the upper right hand corner to register for access or visit www.oceancanyon.com/member-registration.
2. Upon submission, an email is sent to Member Services who will then issue login credentials and grant access to member. Member will receive an email containing a temporary password for access within one business day.

4. Upon successful first login, members will be asked to create a new password and choose a security question and answer which will be used in the future, should a password reset be necessary. You are now ready to request a reservation.
5. To make a dues or loan payment, click on the "Dues & Loan Payments" tab at the top. Ocean Canyon Properties does not accept payments for your dues and loans directly on our site for extra security purposes. On the "My Membership Details" page, you will see two links, one for dues and the other for your loan. By clicking on either link, you will be sent to www.myaccountinfo.com. From here, you will need to create an account with them to make payments toward your dues and loans.

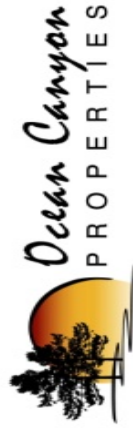

Easy Double Layer Chocolate Pie

Ingredients

Pre-made Oreo Pie Crust

2 cups Half-n-Half
2 pkgs (3.4 oz)
Chocolate Instant Pudding

1 pkg Cool Whip (thawed)

1 Hershey Milk Chocolate Bar (shavings)

Directions

1. Take pie crust out of package and keep in foil.
2. Combine dry pudding mixes and half-n-half in a mixing bowl. Whisk for 2 minutes, until the instant pudding mix is dissolved. Put in refrigerator for about 5 minutes to chill.
3. Create the following layers:

First layer: Take about half of the chocolate pudding mixture and add it into the bottom of the pie crust. Using a spatula, spread it evenly.

Second layer: Add 1/2 of the Cool Whip to the remaining half of the chocolate pudding in the bowl and mix together with spatula to form a uniform mixture. Add this chocolate pudding/Cool Whip mixture on top of the first layer. Use a spatula to even it out.

Cool Whip layer: Add remain Cool Whip on top and spread out evenly. Using a vegetable peeler, shave decorative chocolate shavings out of the Hershey's milk chocolate right over Cool Whip.

Refrigerate the pie for at least 4 hours or overnight to allow the layers to set and become firm.



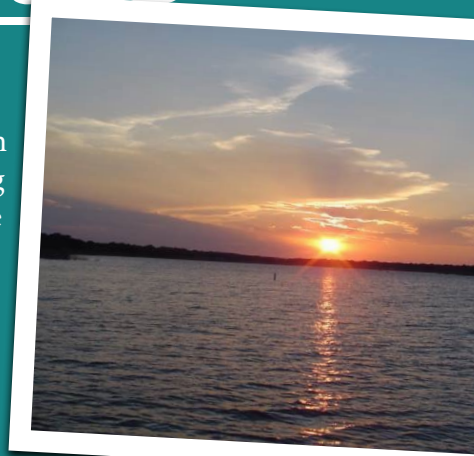
